FAUNCE'S PENNY POST

This penny post delivered letters to and from the post office in Atlantic City, New Jersey from 1884 until 1887. Ancil (Ansel) Faunce, a military veteran, is believed to be the proprietor of the post, having succeeded the original founder, Edward S. Stelz.



Faunce's Penny Post used a red on black circular stamp design. These stamps are very similar to the Hackney & Bolte stamps, another Atlantic City local post.
